SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE RELATING TO TERMINATION OF THE PROPOSED ACQUISITION OF CHILDCARE CENTRE BUSINESS IN TARNEIT, VICTORIA, AUSTRALIA

Under the terms of the Settlement, the parties also release and discharge each other from all claims relating to the said dispute.

The Settlement will not have an impact on the net tangible assets and earnings per share of the Company for the current financial year ending 31 December 2020.

None of the Directors and, to the best knowledge of the Directors, none of the substantial shareholders of the Company has any direct or indirect interest in the Proposed Acquisition or the Settlement, other than through their respective shareholdings and/or directorships, as the case may be, in the Company.
